

ASSIGNMENT FOR ENGLISH

Whether or not you choose to write on problem no. 5, be sure you think it through so that you can discuss this question in class.

Parable of the Cave

1. Draw a diagram of the parable.
2. Tell the difference between reflected image and reality.
3. Explain becoming as compared with being in the conclusion of the parable.
4. What attitude or point of view would the philosopher have? The chained slave? The person able to look at the sun's reflection in the pool?
5. What is reality?
